Dear Members of the Baldwin Community:

It is with great pleasure that we announce that Baldwin's Board of Directors has unanimously approved the Search Committee's recommendation to name Mr. Albert Cauz as Baldwin School's new Head of School beginning July 1, 2009. We are delighted that Mr. Cauz has accepted our invitation to lead Baldwin as it continues its growth as the leading school in our community. Albert comes to us from the Webb School in Nashville, Tennessee, where he has served as headmaster since 2005.

As you know, during the past six months, a seven-member Search Committee of Board of Directors and parents has conducted an extensive national search for a new head. The committee sought a visionary leader and a person with the highest integrity, strong academic credentials, and outstanding communication skills. We were impressed with the overall quality and strength of the candidates interested in Baldwin.

The search committee was impressed with Albert's strong leadership abilities. He is described by former colleagues as "extremely ethical person," "collaborative but not afraid to make decisions," "enrollment builder," "enthusiastic fundraiser," and "a respected figure in our community." He is praised for his excellent interpersonal skills and the strength of his interactions with faculty, students, and parents.

Albert is a superb educator and educational leader who has been headmaster of the Webb School. The Webb School is located in Nashville, Tennessee, a day and boarding school with an enrollment of 300 students in grades sixth through twelfth. Previously he served as Residential Dean and Spanish language and literature teacher at Phillips Andover Academy, Massachusetts, for eleven years. He also served as Foreign Languages Department Chair and teacher at the Cate School in California, and as Spanish language and literature teacher at Choate-Rosemary Hall School in Connecticut.

He received his BA in Spanish Literature at Boston College, Chestnut Hill, MA and an M.A. in Spanish Language and Literature from Middlebury College, Middlebury, VT.


