

## What is Friday Night Off: Babysitting?

Friday Night Off: Babysitting is a fun, 5 hour fun afternoon for Baldwin's first through fourth grade students. The class of 2020 will serve as babysitters from 5:30 to 10:30pm at the Visual Performing Arts Center. We will have several stations where kids can choose to play, make crafts, decorate cookies, do sport-related activities, play video games, and more. Parents! This is our favor to you, for everything you do. Enjoy this night off from the class of 2020. For general registration, the fee per student is \$25. For children of Baldwin teachers, the fee is \$15. In this document you will find the schedule, important things to know, event details, registration form, and admission ticket.

### **Important Things To Know**

- I. How to register
  - A. To register, fill the registration form adjacent to this document and hand in to homeroom teacher on or before **Thursday**, **January 31**<sup>st</sup>.
  - B. Payment methods accepted are ATH Móvil to (787) 247 1697 or cash. Cash is to be attached to registration form when handing in.
  - C. ATH Móvil payments **MUST** include the child's <u>name</u> and <u>grade</u>. Otherwise the payment will be considered invalid.
  - D. Students can still **pay** in **cash** on February 1st but cannot be admitted without prior registration.



1. This allows us to prepare adequately for the amount of students to attend.

# II. Dietary and/or Physical Restrictions

- A. The junior class officers wish that no child is left without the opportunity to participate in any of the activities, for such, we will be accommodating all dietary or physical restrictions as best as possible. We ask that these are communicated before confirming registration to the event.
- B. In the registration form, parents can outline details on their child(s)' restrictions. The junior class officers will communicate with parents to confirm the measures taken to accommodate the restrictions.
- C. Please note that if a student wishes to bring dinner from home, there is a microwave available to facilitate the process during dinner time.

### III. What to wear/bring

- A. Wear: Pajamas + sneakers
  - Students will be both watching movies and doing non-active activities as well as sports-related activities, which is why we require sneakers or closed toe shoes (in accordance to the Baldwin dress code regulations) and comfortable pajamas.

### B. Bring: Small beach chair, pillow and blanket

- 1. No pajama party is complete without pillows, blankets, popcorn and a movie! Please provide your child with a small beach chair, small pillow and small blanket, properly labeled, and we'll provide the rest.
- 2. We'll store all chairs, and bags with pillows and blankets before the movie.

#### IV. Dismissal

- A. Students are not allowed out of the VPAC for the entirety of the event.
  - 1. If a student must be picked up before the dismissal hour, this must be noted in the admission ticket.
  - 2. Students cannot leave the VPAC without a parent or guardian arriving to the VPAC door. Please respect this rule to facilitate security measures and dismissal procedure.

#### **Event Details**

### I. Registration

- A. To register, a student must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and present the completed admission ticket at the end of this form with the proof or purchase or attached fee in cash.
- B. Student will receive a wristband according to his/her age and will proceed to the VPAC.



#### II. Welcome

- A. Junior students will be identified with their yellow class shirt and will welcome students as they register.
- B. Throughout the registration and welcome period, students will get to know each student and accompany them to the VPAC seats for Ice Breakers

### III. Ice Breakers

A. After a headcount and brief welcome, students will be enjoying games led by the junior class officers as they sit with their peers and other junior students for 45 minutes. Half will be inactive games and the rest, active. The games include charades, musical chairs, prop hunt, and others.

## IV. Snack and Optional Dinner Break

- A. A snack and baked goods table will be set up for students in the VPAC.
- B. We will provide pizza (or another food option if a dietary requirement merits it) which is an option for students, unless they prefer eating (or eating a second meal) during the movie.

### V. Fun stations

- A. Students will choose between five stations to begin. Each group of students will rotate every 20-30 minutes. The stations are:
  - 1. Sports
  - 2. Video Games
  - 3. Arts and Crafts
  - 4. Baked goods and cookies (decorating)
  - 5. Ping Pong

## VI. Movie

A. We will project The Incredibles 2 and give popcorn, snacks, and pizza (or another food option if a dietary requirement merits it) to students.
